As we prepare for the season of Lent this coming Ash Wednesday, let us take a moment to understand what we will be undertaking. The traditional purpose of Lent is the preparation for the celebration of the death and resurrection of Our Lord, Jesus Christ through prayer, penance, repentance, almsgiving, and self-denial. In Latin, Lent is referred to as "Quadragesima", meaning "Fortieth." We prepare for forty days with the culmination of Holy Week, in which we recall and celebrate the events of the Passion of Christ on Good Friday, which then culminates in the celebration on Easter Sunday of the resurrection of Jesus Christ.

I remember as a child growing up, I was always fascinated with Lent. Lent was a time when everything in the Church turned purple (officially, it's 'violet'), and at the time, I did not know that violet was the color for repentance.

Holy Week, especially the Triduum (Latin for 'three days'), was also a special time, from Holy Thursday, when the priest would wash the feet of the faithful; Good Friday, when the tabernacle would be empty as the faithful venerate the Holy Cross; Easter Vigil, when the church would be dark to symbolize the darkness of the world until the risen Lord resurrects from the dead to bring Light to those in darkness as we sing "Glory to God in the Highest"; to finally Easter Sunday, when the church is illuminated with the Paschal candle and the scent of Easter lilies wafting in the air.

How will we prepare for this Holy Season? What will we give up? Will we take that step to receive God's mercy in the Sacrament of Reconciliation? Will we <u>make an effort</u> to go to Mass more often? Will we be more charitable toward our neighbor?

As we <u>enter into</u> the holy season of Lent, may the Lord be with us these forty days so that we may celebrate the resurrection of Christ this Easter with renewed and joyful hearts.
