THE SHEPHERDS' TRUST

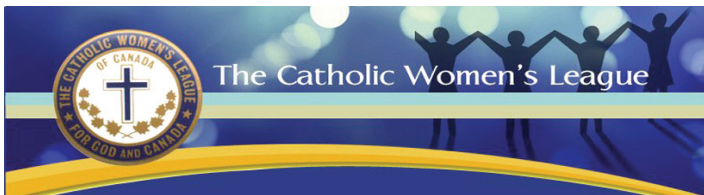
