Catholic Family Services in Orangeville Individual Counselling can be very helpful for:

Coping with extended family. Finding quality time to have fun as a family. When seeking counselling for yourself and your children we ask that the parent(s) attend the first session without their children. (Childcare is available at the Walk-in clinics to make this easier). We do this in order to determine custody and how to proceed in the best way for all involved. If you are separated or divorced you will be asked to bring legal documentation outlining custody agreements to this first session.
