VEILING OF STATUES AND ICONS DURING PASSIONTIDE



In His dolorous Passion, Jesus' face and whole body were so disfigured by the blows and scourges that Our Savior was scarcely recognizable. "I am a worm and not a man" (Psalm 22:6). Thus, the wounds Our Lord endured hid both his divinity and his humanity.

For this reason we veil the crosses in the final days of Lent – hiding our Savior under the sad purple cloth.

The statues of the saints, too, are covered; for it is but befitting that, if the glory of the Master be eclipsed, His servants should not appear.
