First Sunday of Advent



Advent is a season of expectation of the Christ and thus has a joyful tone to it alongside a solemn, preparatory one. It is four weeks long or slightly less, the first two focusing on Jesus' final coming as Lord and judge. The final eight days anticipate His coming history. Since the tenth century, the third Sunday of Advent, traditionally named Gaudete Sunday, expresses the joyful anticipation of our infant Saviour.



A prayer for lighting an Advent wreath at home or school: Lord God, Your Church joyfully awaits the coming of its Saviour, Who enlightens our hearts and dispels all darkness. Pour forth Your blessings upon us, as we light the candles of this wreath; May their light reflect the splendor of Christ, Who is Lord for ever and ever. Amen.




All children must be 12 years of age by **December 31st, 2019** to register for this sacramental preparation programme.


