30% Capacity restrictions apply and safe social distancing measures are in effect.

We want to assure you that the church is thoroughly sanitized before every Mass thanks to a dedicated team of volunteers.

The front doors will open 30 minutes before each Mass and you will be ushered into the church on a first come first served basis.

An usher will escort you and your family to an assigned seat, according to a seating plan.

You may wear your own mask, shield and gloves, although gloves must be removed when receiving Holy Communion.

Hand sanitizer stations are located at the entrance of the church.

There will be no communal singing during Mass.

There will be no Children's Liturgy at this time.

At the Sign of peace, please nod or bow to your neighbour rather than shake hands.

The offertory basket will not be passed around. If you wish to make a donation the basket will be at the back of the church, safe guarded by a volunteer.

At Holy Communion we ask that you follow the direction of the ushers.

At this time Cardinal Thomas Collins has decided that Holy Communion on the tongue will be temporarily suspended. We will return to this practice when it is safe to do so.

If you suddenly feel sick during Mass, please leave the church for the safety of everyone. If you learn you or a family member of your household have tested positive for COVID-19 within 14 days of attending Mass, contact our local public health agency and the parish office. Your identity will be protected, except in conversation with public health officers.

When leaving the church please follow the direction of the ushers and use social distancing.

There will be no mingling in the vestibule or the parking lot following Mass. We ask that you go directly to your car and exit the parking lot.

At this time no socials or meetings will be taking place in the parish hall and the church doors we remain locked at all times other than during Mass.

The parish offices remain closed, and the staff is working remotely from home. If you require assistance please call or email and we will respond as soon as possible.

We look forward to celebrating First Holy Communion Masses for your children who have completed their sacramental preparation from Sept. 2019 thru early spring March 2020 and who have been patiently waiting in great anticipation! Due to capacity restrictions for gatherings in Ontario, we invite you to register for seats for your child's First Holy Communion Mass. Families up to 8 members only from the same household may sit together child/children at a reserved pew. Please note if you have two children from the same household celebrating their First Holy Communion you only need to register once! Please be mindful of others and register only for the Mass you plan to attend and only register members of your own dates/times household. Any multiple registrations for the same child/family will automatically be **DELETED** and your first selection will be honoured.

Online registrations began LIVE Wed. Sept. 9, 2020 at 10:00am.

The <u>limit is 15 children/candidates per Mass</u> with a max. of 8 family members reserving a <u>total</u> of 8 people per pew.


