When Covid-19 was declared a pandemic Pope Frances granted the faithful dispensation from their Sunday obligation, which is still in effect today.

#### **DUFFERIN FOOD SHARE UPDATE**

The Dufferin Food Share will be continuing until September 30, which may be revived depending on the new school year progresses. If progress is made the Food Bank will revert to there previous shopping model.

When Dufferin Food Share started the St. Vincent de Paul gave all their dated food staples to the Food Bank with an understanding that they would return the same amount of food when the pandemic ended.

The St Vincent de Paul has contacted 125 of their most frequent Neighbours in Need (NIN) and the vast majority are coping well and visiting the Food Bank twice a month. Twenty-five have requested assistance and arrangements are being made to provided them with Food Voucher using the necessary safety measures.

Currently the SVDP is NOT distributing food.

#### **Methods of Giving**

Our parish has reopened for Mass following the guidelines set out by the Archdiocese of Toronto and we continue to work diligently to make the environment safe for everyone.

Whether you have returned to the church or are unable to attend in person, we are all aware that the parish relies on the support of our parishioners to operate. Salaries, programs, and operating costs are funded through the generosity of our parish community.

It is challenging for the parish to maintain operations without our usual weekly offertory collection. We have benefited greatly from the Canada Employment Wage Subsidy, but that support is scheduled to diminish after September.

Here are ways that you can continue to support our parish at this time.

Mail in your Sunday envelopes to the parish: St. Timothy Church – 42 Dawson Rd., Orangeville, ON L9W 2W3 <u>OR</u> drop your envelopes through the mail slot, located at the rectory side door (previously the entrance to Mary's office).

Register for Pre Authorized Giving (PAG). This method allows you to donate directly to the parish by a monthly withdrawal from your bank account on the 20<sup>th</sup> of each month. You choose the amount you wish to contribute, and you may donate to both Sunday Offertory and/or ShareLife using this method.

Email <u>lenore.officeadmin@sttimothychurch.ca</u> and a registration form will be provided.

<u>Donate Now</u> is an easy way to contribute. Visit the Archdiocese of Toronto's website and click on Donate Now at the top of the home page. From there a new page will allow you to choose a region (Peel Region). Then you will be taken to a page to choose your parish, the amount of your gift - one time or recurring and the payment method – credit card or chequing account.

Use on-line banking which is the method you may be using to be paying utility bills. E-mail the archdiocese of Toronto at <a href="mailto:campaign@archtoronto.org">campaign@archtoronto.org</a> providing them with your name, address, parish name and municipality. They will email you your account information which you can use to set up the Archdiocese of Toronto as a payee in your on-line banking. Your gift will be forwarded to our parish. You can make a one-time or recurring gift to your offertory.
