I believe that You are present in the Most Holy Sacrament.

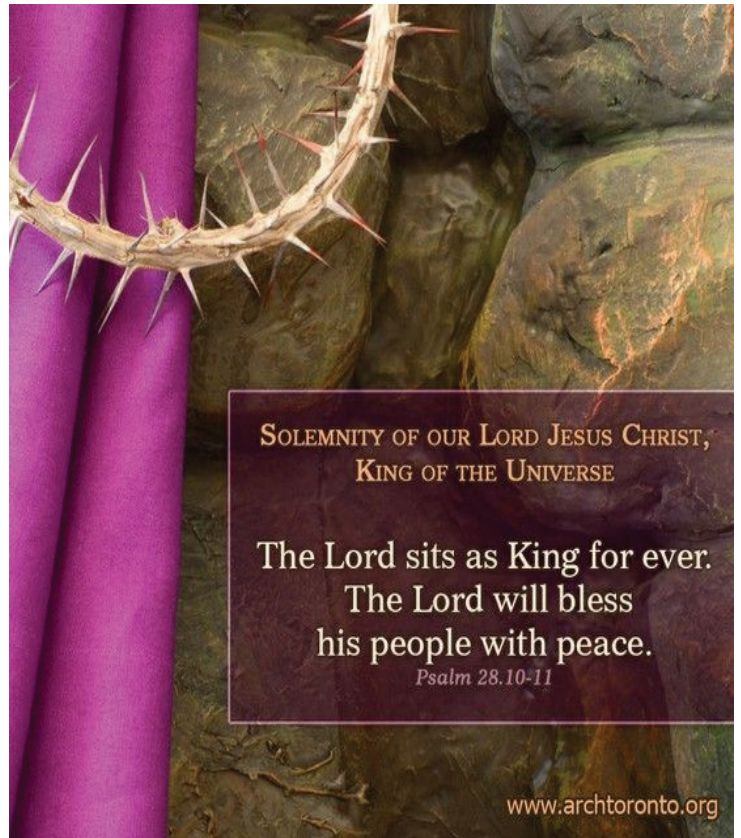
I love You above all things, and I desire to receive You into my soul.

Never permit me to be separated from You. Amen.

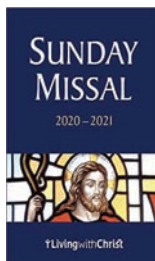
