## LATEST COVID-19 UPDATE Effective January 5, 2022

Capacity restrictions for places of worship are set at 50% of pre-Covid capacity, however distancing of 2 metres must be maintained by those not in the same family. We will continue with our present seating plan, which is well within the restriction.

Out of love for one another, we will continue to follow the rigorous protocols of social distancing, wearing a mask *covering both your mouth and nose* and hand sanitizing. We ask that you please wear your mask, while waiting in line outside the church.

Self sign-in continues for contact tracing purposes, which will allow us to call attendees should a positive case be reported.

Considering the highly contagious Omicron variant, the archdiocese strongly recommends against congregational singing for the time being.

It is disappointing, but meetings in the parish hall have been suspended, as indoor gathering numbers have been reduced to 5 people.

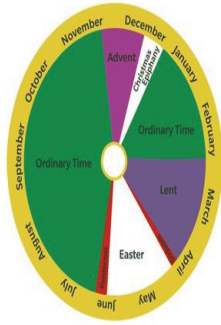
The staff will work virtually when possible, and we encourage parishioners to communicate with the offices by phone or e-mail instead of in-person when possible.

### Celebrating Ordinary Time

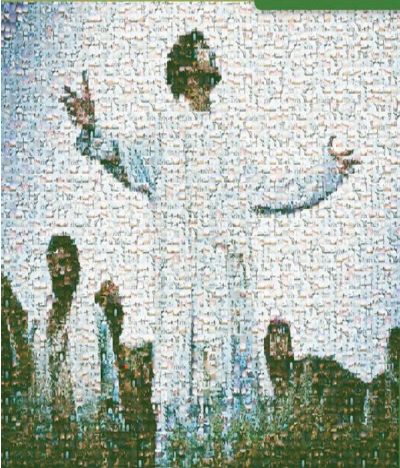
In Ordinary Time the Church unfolds the whole of Christ's mystery, our hope and life in Him, especially at Holy Mass on Sundays as the Word enables us to grow and bear good fruit in "time throughout the year" (*tempus per annum*)

Ordinary Time is... the time between the end of the Christmas Season and the start of Lent; and the end of the Easter Season to the start of Advent. It is a season of growth and rest, of learning about and walking with Christ in his daily life and mission.

- Sundays are marked numerically (eg. First Sunday in Ordinary Time)
- Green is the colour for Sundays and ferial days



Ordinary Time allows us time to reflect on the ministry and mission of Christ on earth and how we might participate in it. It is a time for us to catch our breath from Christmas or Easter and get busy just being Christians in the world.
