### MASS INTENTIONS

Masses can be offered for anyone you love, living or deceased, at our church. There are two kinds of Masses available:

<u>Announced Masses</u> – you may offer this Mass at a chosen date and the intention is announced at the beginning of Mass. Donation is \$20.00. We only book one intention per Mass, which can be offered for an individual, a couple or family. We are presently booking in March 2022. One of the weekend Masses is always offered for the intentions of the People of St Timothy Church.

<u>Unannounced Masses</u> – you may offer this Mass which will be celebrated at one of the Mission churches in the Diocese. Donation is \$10.00. The names and donations are forwarded to the Archdiocese of Toronto, Spirituals Affairs Office, at the end of June and December each year.

If you would like to have a Mass Intention offered for a loved one, please email Lenore at the parish office.

If you are new to the area and/or using pink Visitors' Offertory Envelopes, please call or email lenore.officedmin@sttimothychurch.ca requesting a registration form. ONLY registered parish parishioners receive a tax receipt for their contributions.

If you moved in 2021 please advise the office of your new mailing address.

The tax receipts will be mailed out in the middle of February for donations received at the parish. Tax receipts for donations to the parish through the Archdiocese of Toronto "Donate Now" Program will be mailed to you directly by the Archdiocese.

The St. Vincent De Paul issue their own tax receipts.

The 2022 offertory envelopes are in the vestibule, ready for pick up. Please be sure to only take the envelope box with your name and number. If your address is incorrect contact the parish office, as soon as possible to ensure that your tax receipt is mailed to the correct address.

Note that if you had a box number greater than 700 in 2019 you now have a new number!

# LATEST COVID-19 UPDATE Effective January 5, 2022

Capacity restrictions for places of worship are set at 50% of pre-Covid capacity, however distancing of 2 metres must be maintained by those not in the same family. We will continue with our present seating plan, which is well within the restriction.

Out of love for one another, we will continue to follow the rigorous protocols of social distancing, wearing a mask covering both your mouth and nose and hand sanitizing. We ask that you please wear your mask, while waiting in line outside the church.

Self sign-in continues for contract tracing purposes, which will allow us to call attendees should a positive case be reported.

Considering the highly contagious Omicron variant, the archdiocese strongly recommends against congregational singing for the time being.

It is disappointing, but meetings in the parish hall have been suspended, as indoor gathering numbers have been reduced to 5 people.

The staff will work virtually when possible, and we encourage parishioners to communicate with the offices by phone or e-mail instead of in-person when possible.
