LATEST COVID-19 UPDATE Effective February 17, 2022

On February 14th it was announced by the provincial government that most of the provincial Covid-19 restrictions will be eliminated in two phases over the coming weeks. The first phase began on February 17th and the second will begin on March 1st.

These are the changes that effect us now:

- Our capacity limit will remain the same for the time being. Two metres/six feet of physical distancing is still required at religious ceremonies. Our seating remains the same
- Masks are required indoors.
- **NEW:** The parish hall can reopen for non-sacramental use with a maximum of 50 people.
- **NEW:** Congregational singing can resume!
- **NEW:** Recording contact tracing information is no longer required by the provincial government nor local public health agencies in the archdiocese.
- **NEW:** Parishes can resume offertory collections in the pews, *however* for the time being we will continue with one offertory basket at the back of the church.
