Where do the ashes come from?

The ashes are made from the blessed palms used in the Palm Sunday celebration of the previous year.



WHY THE ASHES?

"For You have made us for Yourself, and our hearts are restless until they find rest in You."
-St. Augustine of Hippo

Ashes are a public sign of our intent to **die to our worldly desires** and **live in Christ.**

As our foreheads are marked with ashes, these words are said: **"Remember, that you are dust, and unto dust you shall return."**

Ashes were used as a sign of repentance in the Old Testament:

"Then I turned to the Lord God, to seek an answer by prayer and supplication with fasting and sackcloth and ashes. I prayed to the Lord my God and made confession" -Daniel 9: 3-4

We thank our volunteers for their tireless efforts to serve the faithful and foster a safe environment for all.

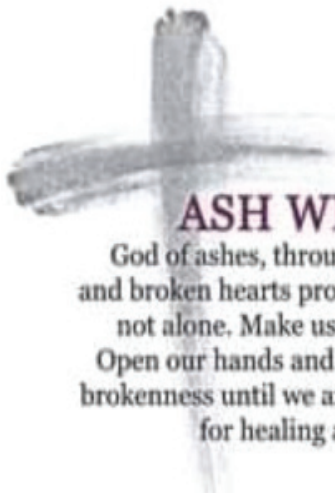
Catholics often light candles for deceased loved ones or someone who is sick. Prayers are often said for those in need of divine intervention or a divine blessing or when seeking divine guidance. Lighting a votive candle can also be in gratitude for a blessing received.

Our church has three votive candle racks, located at the back of the church by the Confessional. Kneelers are positioned in front of each rack for you to use if you wish to kneel when praying. Each lit candle burns for approximately four hours.

A donations of \$1.00 for each candle you light would be appreciated.
