
Multiple Intention Masses

Commencing May 1st, 2024 we will be offering Multiple Intention Masses at every Wednesday 7:00pm Mass and every Thursday 9:00am Mass, with a maximum of 20 intentions per Mass.

If you have already booked an intention for a loved one (deceased or living) on a Wednesday or Thursday from May 1^{st} through to December 26^{th} your intention remains, however other intentions could be added on the day.

Note that Multiple Intention Masses must be restricted to a maximum of 2 masses per week and always on the same day and at the same time, and not on Sunday (Sat. 5pm Vigil Mass, Sun. 9am & 11am).

The stipend for Announced Mass Intentions remains at \$20.00 per mass.

Parish Funeral Reception Volunteers Needed to Resume:



Funeral Reception Volunteers provide a luncheon for family and friends of deceased members of the parish. Volunteers can participate in **1 and/or 2 ways**:

Set-up & Take-down: Volunteers meet the morning of the funeral to set-up tables and chairs and afterwards take down the tables and chairs. A team of 2-3 volunteers usually work each funeral.

Serving the Luncheon: Volunteers prepare hot and cold refreshments only, give access to the Caterer to deliver pre-ordered food only, organise paper plates, cups, and napkins, and tablecloths, serve during the luncheon and remove tablecloths and wipe down tables afterwards. A team of 4-5 volunteers usually work each funeral.

Time: About **4 hours** per funeral. This is a great ministry that provides a welcoming and caring environment for our Parish families and their friends in their time of grief.

[High Risk Screening protocols mandatory] Contact Mary Chiasson, Lay Pastoral Associate <u>Host Families</u>: The role of the Totus Tuus Host Family is to provide accommodations for two to four missionaries for five nights (they arrive the Sunday before the start of the camp and depart the following Friday). Note: Missionaries will be at the Parish most of the time (approximately from 8:00am-9:30pm), with the possibility of a return to the host family in-between day and evening camps.

<u>Adult Camp Volunteers:</u> assist the parish Staff and Missionaries to provide a faith-filled, safe, and fun camp experience for children from grades 1-12. <u>Attend</u> Totus Tuus Training session. Supervising and interacting with campers, assuring their safety, health, and well-being. Participate in Mass activities by singing, responding, etc., to help children worship and learn. Always model respectful and appropriate behaviour. Assist in the physical set-up and take-down of chairs, tables, etc. Cleans up and returns materials to their proper storage area after each session.
