


The new Sunday Missal is available for \$6.00 per copy. Books are located on the table in the vestibule by the parish offices. Place payment in the offering box above the books.

# MASS INTENTIONS

Masses can be offered for anyone you love, living or deceased, at our church. There are two kinds of Masses available:

<u>Announced Masses</u> – you may offer this Mass at a chosen date and the intention is announced at the beginning of Mass. Donation is \$20.00. We only book one intention per Mass, which can be offered for an individual, a couple or family. One of the weekend Masses is always offered for the intentions of the People of St Timothy Church.

<u>Unannounced Masses</u> – you may offer this Mass which will be celebrated at one of the Mission churches in the Diocese. Donation is \$10.00. The names and donations are forwarded to the Archdiocese of Toronto, Spirituals Affairs Office, at the end of June and December each year.

Wednesday 7:00pm & Thursday 9:00am Announced Masses – we book multiple intentions on these two days.

We ask that you please park in an empty designated parking space BEFORE using the lane parking area. If you need to leave immediately after mass, consider parking in the axillary lot by the Rectory. Note that the lane closest to the church front doors MUST always be accessible for emergency vehicles.

### **<u>Pre-Authorized Giving Plan</u>**

The Archdiocese of Toronto has established a Pre-Authorized Giving (PAG) plan to assist you in your support of the work of the parish through your regular parish offerings.
