MARY'S MODESTY


St Ambrose holds up Mary as an example of modesty. She spent her time alone with

These funds are used to make necessary repairs and improvements to both our church and rectory.


The BIF (green) envelopes are included in your offertory box and are also available at all the church entrances. The collection will be taken up after Holy Communion. We thank you for your generosity.

WORLD DAY OF THE SICK

St Timothy Parish Mass Celebrations Including the rite for the Sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick on:

Who may be anointed?
This sacrament is not for those only who are at the point of death. Hence, as soon as anyone of the faithful begins to be in danger of death from sickness or old age, it is fitting for them to receive this sacrament. It is also fitting to receive the Anointing of the Sick prior to a serious operation.





In the modern Christian era, a so-called "ordinary" jubilee year occurs once every 25 years. During these years the faithful are invited to take advantage of an expanded opportunity to experience the transformation that God's holiness makes possible. During this particular jubilee year, Pope Francis invites all to reflect upon the virtue of hope as an important aspect of the Christian Life. In the period between ordinary jubilee years, the Pope can choose to proclaim an "extraordinary" jubilee. This is what Pope Francis did with the 2016 Jubilee of Mercy. The Holy Doors of Saint Peter's Basilica at the Vatican are open until 6 January 2026. Jubilee celebrations are observed around the world until 28 December 2025.

In the Archdiocese of Toronto, several churches have been designated as pilgrimage sites for the duration of the Jubilee, including Saint Michael's Cathedral Basilica in Toronto; Saint Paul's Basilica, Toronto; Saint Padre Pio Parish, Kleinburg; Martyrs' Shrine, Midland; Saint Mary's Parish, Brampton; St. Mary's Parish, Barrie; St. Barnabas Parish, Scarborough; St. Edward the Confessor Parish, North York; St. Mary's Parish, Toronto, Our Lady of Sorrows Parish, Etobicoke; and St. Gregory the Great Parish, Oshawa. The usual requirements to gain an indulgent is to visit one of the above Churches, go to Confession and to receive Holy Communion. Visit http://archtoronto.org/jubilee for resources across the archdiocese.

Further information will be forthcoming regarding pilgrimage opportunities this year with Fr Gustavo and his parishioners as well as information relating to plenary indulgences as part of pilgrimages during the Jubilee Year.
