Weekly reflection from Fr. Gustavo



Finding God in Quietness

Life is loud, busy, chaotic. Often, we assume that the loudest voice in a crowd carries the most truth or influence. Yet, in contrast to our noisy world, God chooses to speak in whispers. The passage

from Kings assures us that this is indeed an intentional choice.

God can command great winds and thundering quakes. But in gentle whispers, God appears to Elijah with intimacy so contrary to the appearance at the altar of Ba'al. To hear a whisper we must quiet our minds and hearts. We learn to seek God's voice through quietness and solitude, amidst the distraction of our loud, noisy world, through the example of Elijah's encounter with God in 1 Kings 19.



CONSECRATION TO JESUS THROUGH MARY

<h2>Paschal Triduum</h2> <p>The Easter Triduum or Holy Triduum is the three-day celebration of the Paschal Mystery: the Passion, death and resurrection of Jesus Christ</p>	<p>PASCHAL: associated with the Hebrew Passover, referring to Jesus as the Lamb of God</p> <p>TRIDUUM: derived from the Latin for three days</p>	<p>The Paschal Triduum bridges the seasons of Lent to Easter.</p> <p>In the Sacred Triduum, the Church solemnly celebrates the greatest mysteries of our redemption, keeping by means of special celebrations the memorial of her Lord, crucified, buried, and risen. <small>The Roman Missal</small></p>
	<p>The Paschal mystery has two aspects: by his death, Christ liberates us from sin; by his Resurrection, he opens for us the way to a new life.</p>	
<p>DAY 1: sundown on Holy Thursday to sundown on Good Friday</p>	<p>HOLY THURSDAY: "Jesus gives himself to us as food and, in the washing of feet, teaches us the need to serve others."</p>
