Weekly reflection from Fr. Gustavo



Mary the greatest role model for mothers Motherhood has always been a sacred and noble vocation, but Mary raised it to even greater level when she became the Mother of God. As the mother who is "blessed among women" (Lk 1:42), Mary gives us the

clearest and most inspiring picture of what the ideal mother should look like. On Mother's Day, most of us will shower our earthly moms with praise. Others, whose moms are absent, may grieve a loss. But all of us have another mother—the one who never fails us, who is ever-present to us, who only modeled virtue for us, whose prayers for us protect us: Mary.....And she's worth celebrating.

Mary, our mother, was brave to cooperate so fully with God. "Let it be to me according to your word," she said. Mary's trust in God is so deep that she didn't even ask for details before she agreed to do what He wanted her to do. 
Sow the seeds of hope for the next generation


