Weekly reflection from Fr. Gustavo

St. John Vianney, the Cure d'Ars, preached extensively on the Eucharist, particularly on the Feast of Corpus Christi, emphasizing its significance as the real presence of Christ and the source of grace for believers. He urged his parishioners to approach the Eucharist with awe and reverence, highlighting its power to transform lives and bring them closer to God. St. John Vianney emphasized that the Eucharist is not just a symbol, but the actual Body and Blood of Christ, present under the appearance of bread and wine.

He encouraged his parishioners to approach the Eucharist with deep respect and awe, recognizing the immense love and power of God present in the sacrament. St. John Vianney believed that frequent and devout reception of Holy Communion could lead to profound spiritual growth, transforming individuals and drawing them closer to sainthood.

**WHAT IS A CORPUS CHRISTI PROCESSION?**  
A Corpus Christi procession is a Eucharistic procession.  
It is a prolongation of the celebration of the Eucharist on the Solemnity of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ. Immediately after Mass, the Sacred Host that is consecrated during the Mass, is borne out of the Church for the faithful **“to make public profession of faith and worship of the Most Blessed Sacrament.”**
