

Reflection from Fr. Gustavo

St. Alphonsus Liguori frequently referenced St. Peter and St. Paul in his writings, particularly in the context of faith, salvation, and the Church. He highlighted their roles as foundational apostles, emphasizing their individual charisms and the unity they represented within the Christian faith.

St. Alphonsus often pointed to St. Peter's faith and his role as the first Pope, emphasizing the importance of obedience to the Church's teachings. While acknowledging St. Peter's denial of Christ, St. Alphonsus also stressed the profound repentance and forgiveness he received, using it as an example of God's mercy.

St. Alphonsus admired St. Paul's missionary zeal and his role in bringing the Gospel to the Gentiles, emphasizing the universality of Christianity. He often quoted St. Paul's writings on grace, highlighting that salvation comes through God's grace and not solely through human effort. St. Alphonsus admired St. Paul's dramatic conversion from persecutor to apostle, using it as an example of the transformative power of God's grace.

St. Alphonsus held up both apostles as examples of holiness and discipleship, encouraging believers to follow their example in their own lives.
