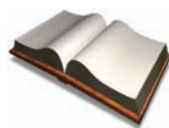

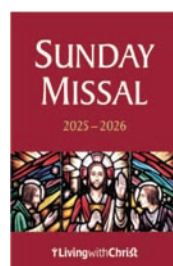

Sanctuary Candle

One of the church's earliest traditions is to burn candles to offer prayers to God. Beside the Tabernacle, the red Sanctuary candle remains lit to signify and honour the real presence of Christ.

For a donation of \$20.00 your special intention or memory of a deceased loved one will be remembered for one week beginning on Sunday. It is an unannounced intention which will be posted in the bulletin.
