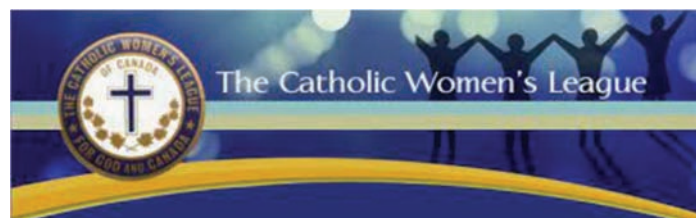

## PARISH REGISTRATIONS & TAX RECEIPT FOR DONATIONS

Welcome new parishioners who have moved into our parish boundaries.

To be a registered member of our Parish is to have a sense of belonging to a Community of Faith. Registration is necessary when requesting reference letters, eligibility for the sacraments, offertory envelopes and a tax receipt for your donations.

If you are using generic envelopes regularly, but have not completed a Registration Form we can not issue a tax receipt. Registration Forms are available in the file folder in the vestibule by the stairs.

## **PRE-AUTHORIZED GIVING PLAN**

The Archdiocese of Toronto has established a Pre-Authorized Giving (PAG) plan to assist you in your support of the work of the parish through your regular parish offerings. To accomplish the mission entrusted to us by Christ, the parishes depend entirely on the generosity of their parishioners. PAG allows you to give to your parish through scheduled monthly transfer, from your bank account or credit card. These funds are then deposited directly into the parish account.

## **MASS INTENTIONS**

**Announced Masses** – you may offer this Mass at a chosen date and the intention is announced at the beginning of Mass. Donation is \$20.00. We only book one intention per Mass on Tuesday's and Friday's and multiple intentions of Wednesday's and Thursday's, which can be offered for an individual, a couple or family.

One of the weekend Masses is always offered for the intentions of the People of St Timothy Church.

**Unannounced Masses** – you may offer this Mass which will be celebrated at a Mission church in the Diocese. Donation is \$10.00. The names and donations are forwarded to the Archdiocese of Toronto, Spirituals Affairs Office, at the end of June and December each year.

## **SANCTUARY CANDLE**
